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# **Board business**

# I. Ratification of minutes from prior meeting

Minutes from 1/16/2005 were ratified.

# II. Treasurer Report

The Treasurer submitted a quarterly report as seen here:

Budget for 2006

- The treasurer is estimating flat income 2005 to 2006, though we may see some upside by using the escalation process on delinquent accounts.
- Expenses expected to be equal to or slightly less than income.
- Includes normal insurance, maintenance, and other expenses.
- One unusual item is maintenance costs of \$2000.00 for treating the fence along 185th.

## <u>Old Business</u>

- 1 Fence Scott is getting bids for the fence staining. It is planned to use a different contractor who is more available and cheaper. It is estimated that the fence will be stained by the next meeting.
- 2 Trees Scott reported that an attorney advised him that any change to the CCRs which affected an existing homeowner's trees, would require 100% agreement.
- 3 Centex The letter that the Secretary sent to Washington County regarding the development and our requests.

# New Business

- 1. Centex has contacted several homeowners indicating that some fence lines are on Centex property.
- 2. A homeowner requested that the sign at the entrance be made larger or buffed or otherwise enhanced. Lou agreed to investigate possible alternatives.
- 3. Scott requested that homeowners work together to form a work party to plant additional trees and shrubs rather than use a contractor or continue to use a contractor. Scott proposes that an email be sent to all homeowners requesting volunteers for a work party by April 20, 2006. If there are not 6 volunteers agreeing



to form a work party by the end of April, the association agrees to proceed with phase 2 of the original plan. The measure was passed.

- 4. It was reported that a weld on the gate that blocks access to the fire lane is broken. Bryan will call the fire department to see if they are responsible to repair.
- 5. Scott will report that a street light is out.
- 6. Sandy brought up the summer block party. Sandy will seek volunteers and do the planning.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:22pm.
